



The Scaling Community of Practice (SCoP) is launching a five-year **Scaling Campaign 2026-2030** to respond to the current international development and climate crisis. Building on ten years of action learning, the SCoP Scaling Campaign will promote transformational scaling, an approach that creates long-term pathways to impact at the scale of the problem. By 2030, the Campaign will help create a tipping point where a systematic emphasis on transformational scaling becomes standard practice across the global institutional development and climate ecosystems.

Since 2015, the SCoP has grown into a broad-based, multi-sector community of more than **5,000 members from over 1,300 organizations in 127 countries**, most of them in the Global South. Guided by a diverse **Executive Committee, High Level Advisory Group, and Leadership Team**, and drawing on detailed **case studies of 28 development and climate finance organizations**, the SCoP has helped shape global scaling guidance, develop tools and standards, and generate practical evidence on how to integrate scaling into institutional practice. These past efforts and the SCoP's leadership in the field, including through its 9 sectoral and thematic working groups and its **action research program**, provide a strong foundation for the Campaign that will now mobilize leaders and partners worldwide to make transformational scaling the new norm.

To deliver this agenda, the SCoP is inviting a small group of Sustaining Members to contribute \$15,000 per year and play a direct role in steering and amplifying the Campaign.
